Who had had this car for 3 days ?

Past Ind + T. E = Past Perfect  
V<sub>2</sub>      [since/for + time]      [Had V<sub>3</sub>]

✓ I had had a book for 3 days — Past Perfect

⇒ मेरे पास 3 दिन से एक किताब थी।





2006 से — Since 2006.

For — Period of time — (Indefinite time)

Since — Point of time — (Definite time)

⇒ सोमवार से — Since Monday.

4 घंटे से — for four hours.

Had V3 Past Perfect ← Before (पहले) → Past Indefinite (V2)

Past Indefinite (V2) ← After (बाद) → Past Perfect  
↳ had V3

had taken

⇒ I took food before my father went.

I took food after my father went had gone.

⇒ Rules —

S/S	—	was	} V.Iing ↓ M.V
P/S	—	were	
I	—	was	

⇒ Subj + was/were + V.Iing + obj + o.w —

② She never — me (abuse)

③ Do you not — your work on time (Do)

④ I went to school after my father had — (go)

⑤ It — raining in this area since Monday. (Have been)

⑥ Who — cricket with you daily. (Play)
