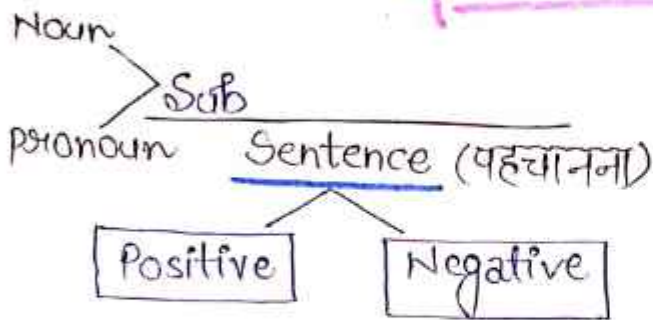

(Sub)

Have they?

⇒ She does not do this work. — Did she?
[Home work]

⇒ My father beats me. — Does he?

⇒ These students can do it. — Couldn't they?

⇒ My mother cooked food. — Didn't my mother?

⇒ My teacher should teaches. — should he?
