Birth: October 16, (1888)

Died: November 27, (1953)

Father: James O'Neill

Mother: Mary Ellen Quinlan.

They both were theater actors.



DSSB (TOT) ENGLISH (Lit.)





- He is the First American playwright to win the Nobel prize in Literature in 1936.
- > He is the only dramatist to win four Pulitzer prize in his life.
- > His plays were among the first to introduce into American drama, techniques of realism







- After O'Neill was born her mother develops addiction to morphine.
- > In 1895 O'Neill was sent to St. Aloysius Academy for Boys, a Catholic boarding school








- > O'Neill spent several years at (sea) during which he suffered from depression and alcoholism.
- > He married thrice in his life.







> In (918) he married Agnes Boulton and had two children Shane and Oona.









- Later on, his son Eugene O'Neill Jr. suffered from alcoholism and committed suicide in 1950
- > In 1943, O'Neill disowned his daughter Oona for marrying the English actor Charlie Chaplin when she was 18 and Chaplin was 54.
- > In 1953 O'Neill died at the Sheraton Hotel, Boston.
