Adjective is a word which qualifies a noun or a pronoun.

⇒ She is my beautiful wife.

⇒ I work hard Adv.

⇒ Come fast to me.

⇒ It's hard work for me.

⇒ Do it quickly Adv.

⇒ Do it very quickly.



Subject + Verb + So + Adjective + that + Subject + Aux. + M.V. + ...

She is ^{so} too lazy that she cannot do it.

They are too honest that they cannot accept any bribe.

① Too + Adj के बाद that clause है - Too के स्थान पर so आयेगा

so.

② so + Adj के बाद To + V I है तो so के स्थान पर too लिखते हैं।

My grandfather is too old that he cannot walk.

(c) Too + Adjective/Adverb के बाद Infinitive (to + Verb) का प्रयोग शुद्ध माना जाता है, इसलिए that- clause का प्रयोग नहीं करना चाहिए और too की जगह so का प्रयोग नहीं करना चाहिए। इस तरह के वाक्य में Infinitive का अर्थ नकारात्मक (Negative) होता है।

* so + Adj के साथ to + VI का so का स्थान पर too लिखने है।

Too + Adjective/Adverb + to + Verb.....

She is ^{too} so weak to walk.

He ran ^{too} so fast to be caught up with.

The lion was ^{too} so weak to run.

Rule 2: 'Too much' and 'Much too': हमें हमेशा याद रखना चाहिए कि too much के बाद Noun का प्रयोग होता है और much too के बाद Adjective का प्रयोग होता है।

The journey was ^{much too} too much long. - Adj

The task is ^{much too} too much ^{Adj} difficult to do. Noun

I have already faced ^{too much} much too difficulty in managing these people.
