WB Police Constable Syllabus 2023

Candidates should note that they must plan their preparation strategy according to the WB Police Constable Syllabus prescribed by the authorities. Check details of the same below.

WB Police Constable Syllabus Preliminary Written Test and Final Written Exam

The questions in the WB Police Constable Prelims & Mains will be based on General Awareness and General Knowledge, Reasoning, and Elementary Mathematics. Questions in the final written exam also be based on English Language. The subject-wise WB Police Constable syllabus is given below.

WB Police Constable Syllabus 2023 – PMT/PET and Interview

- The PMT/PET are qualifying in nature i.e. candidates must qualify both the stages, but they will not receive any marks for the same.
- The interview round is worth 15 marks and the questions are designed to test the suitability of the candidates for the vacancy.
- The final selection of the candidates is based on the marks scored in the final written exam and the interview.

West Bengal Police Constable Exam Pattern 2023

- WB Police Constable Exam Pattern comprises 5 different selection stages which the candidates must qualify to be eligible for selection as WB Police Constable. The five selection stages are Preliminary Written Exam,

PMT/PET, Final Written Exam, and an Interview. The details regarding West Bengal Police Constable Exam Pattern 2023 for different selection stages are discussed here.

Preliminary Written Test

- This test shall comprise of 100 multiple-choice objective-type questions.
- Every question is worth 1 mark. There is a negative marking of $\frac{1}{4}$ mark for each wrongly answered question.
- There is no negative marking for attempted questions.
- The paper is set in Bengali and Nepali language.
- The time duration for the paper is 1 hour.

Interview

The final selection stage consists of a personal interview wherein a candidate's personality traits and suitability for the job will be tested. The verification roll will also be verified at this time. Shortlisted candidates will be deputed as Police Constable with the West Bengal Police Department, subject to them clearing the medical test. It will carry a weightage of 15 marks.
